2010 DON PIEPER SCHOLARSHIP AWARD APPLICATION

PURPOSE

The Don Pieper / Illinois PGA Foundation Scholarship Award seeks to encourage and promote the attainment of higher education goals for youth in the following two categories: 1) children, grandchildren, child-in-laws, nieces or nephews of Illinois Section PGA members and 2) Illinois residents pursuing a degree in Professional Golf Management (PGM).

The 2010 Don Pieper Scholarship Award is generously funded through the Don Pieper Endowment Fund held at the Illinois PGA Foundation.

SCHOLARSHIP COMPOSITION

- The Illinois PGA Foundation will award a maximum of six \$1,000 scholarships for the 2010-2011 academic year.
- Applicants will be evaluated on academic achievement as well as extracurricular and community involvement.
- All scholarship award checks will be made payable to the applicant and his/her educational institution.

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicants must be a son, daughter, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, grandchild, niece or nephew of an Illinois PGA member.
- Additionally, any individual who resides within the geographic boundaries of the Illinois PGA Section and is currently enrolled in a Professional Golf Management Program (PGM) at one of the PGA accredited colleges or universities offering such a program, shall be eligible for a Foundation Scholarship Award.
- Applicants must be enrolled full-time at an accredited institution of higher learning or, in the case of high school seniors, be accepted at such an institution for the next academic year (verification required).
- The Illinois PGA member sponsoring the applicant must be an active class A member.
- Scholarships are not automatically renewed. Past Scholarship recipients must reapply the following year.

HOW TO APPLY

Students must complete and submit the attached application form and supply the following under one cover:

- Transcripts from all high schools or colleges attended
- Graduating high school seniors must attach a collegiate letter of acceptance to their application
- Letters of recommendation from 1) an Illinois PGA Professional and 2) a high school or college official
- All applications must be received by June 1, 2010
